SUSTAIN ended 2024 with a flury of activity, and the pace has increased in the first two months of 2025. During January and February 2025, SUSTAIN has:

- submitted its first annual report to ICOM
- created its first member survey (first item below and available HERE)
- registered its support for ICOM-EUROPE's SAREC application to pursue training in decolonization with ICOM-AFRICA
- committed to participating in the ICOM 27th General Conference in Dubai in November 2025
- responded to requests from ICOM to advise on efforts to emphasize culture in global conversations about sustainability, as outlined in Culture2030 goals and through ICOM's participation at G20 South Africa, COP30 Brazil, and the 2025 World Conference on Cultural Policies (MONDIACULT) in Spain
- discussed ICOM's request for a SUSTAIN member to sit on an advisory committee to Culture for the Planet (you can read more about that initiative HERE).
- scheduled meetings with FLA (International Federation of Library and Archives) and CIMAM (International Committee for Museums and Collections of Modern Art) to discuss shared sustainability goals,
- and numerous other details as outlined below.
